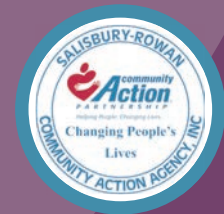

November 1942 – March 2010

Albert "Sug" Ruff Jr.

Weatherization director and assistant director for the Salisbury-Rowan Community Action Agency Inc. Albert was a graduate of Dunbar High School and received his Bachelor of Arts in Sociology from Livingstone College. He received

numerous community service awards including 2008 NAACP "Man of the Year." For 42 years, Albert worked with Salisbury-Rowan Community Action Agency Inc. (3/4/1968 – 3/17/2010).

Education was a priority for both namesakes of this scholarship. In honor of their memory and community action legacy, a scholarship will be presented each year to support higher education.

The Elizabeth P. Fields and Albert "Sug" Ruff Jr. Memorial Community Action Scholarship Fund award can be used by the recipient for any school-related costs.
